
#### Understanding the Problem



- Disproportionate impacts on low-income communities and communities of color
- Historically, policies and programs have been insufficient to address equity concerns
- Communities of color lack access to green technology and investments
- Underserved communities are not sufficiently engaged in decision-making processes



### AB 32 – Global Warming Solutions Act



Sets a statewide limit on carbon pollution and directing the California Air Resources Board to create a roadmap to roll back emissions to 1990 levels by 2020.




# SB 535 (De Leon 2012)

- Requires a minimum 25% of the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund benefits disadvantaged communities.
- Requires a minimum of 10% of the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund to be located in disadvantaged communities.
- Requires funded programs to maximize co-benefits.










\*Estimates do not include High Speed Rail and cover other awarded projects through 2015




